What is the PTA?

The Parent Teacher Association is a group of parents who work alongside school staff to discuss ways of raising additional money for the school, and to support the school in buying equipment, toys and small gifts for the children (eg at Christmas and Easter).

What sort of things do we organise?

We organise:

- Book stall
- The 200 club
- 2nd hand uniform sales
- Family camp
- Christmas and Summer Fayres
- 'Allesley's Got Talent', Magic shows, Fashion Shows and other evening events
- Cake sales organised by teaching staff

What have we raised money for?

In just the last 12 months, we have raised over £6000 for new Foundation Stage playground equipment as well as making decisions to spend money raised over the last couple of years by using over £10,000 for laptops, Ipods & Ipads, £1,500 to fund the repair of the Funfit Trail, and we are currently raising funds for a new outdoor Wildlife Area and KS1 funfit areas. Cake sale money is spent by the class teachers after discussion with the children about what to buy for their classroom.
