What is the EasyPeasy app?

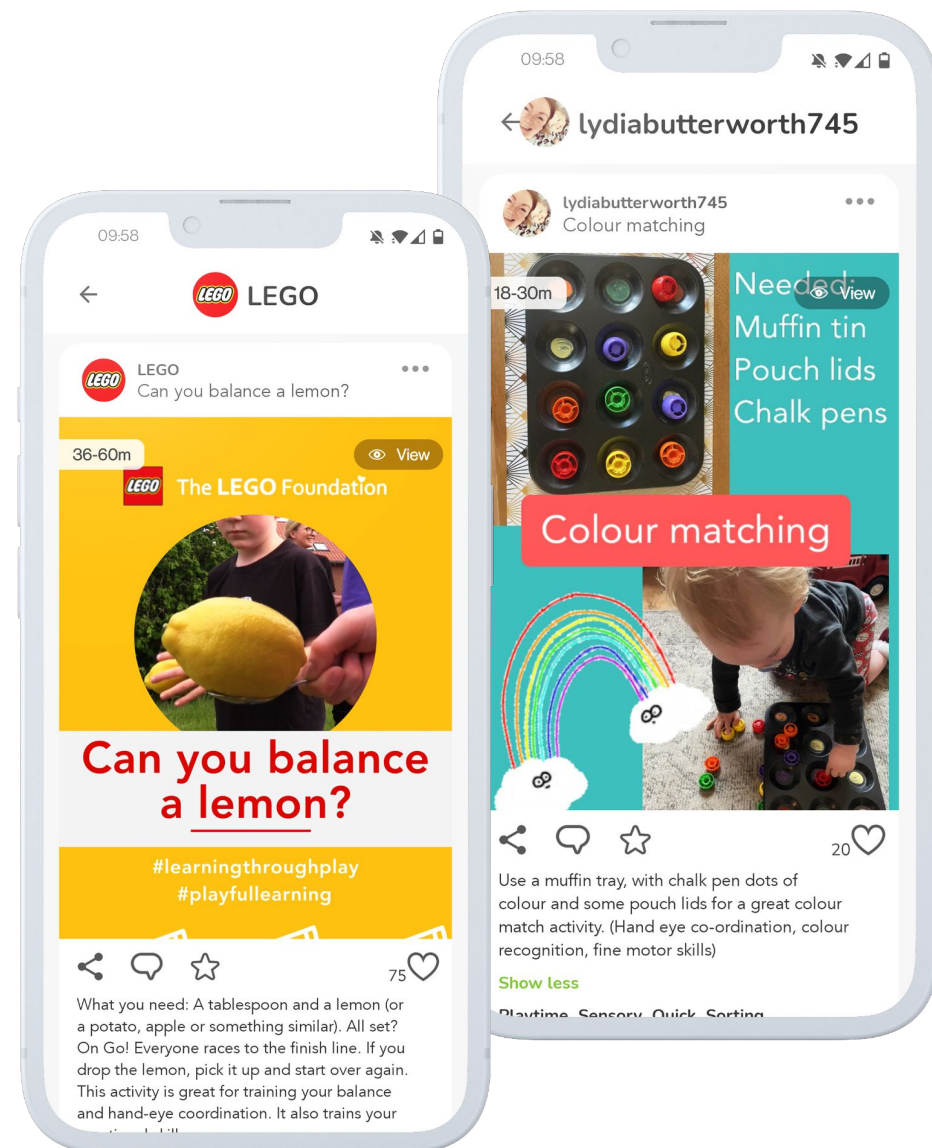
The EasyPeasy app brings together the best ideas, advice, and inspiration from a global community of parents, experts, and parenting brands for parents and their 0-5 year olds.

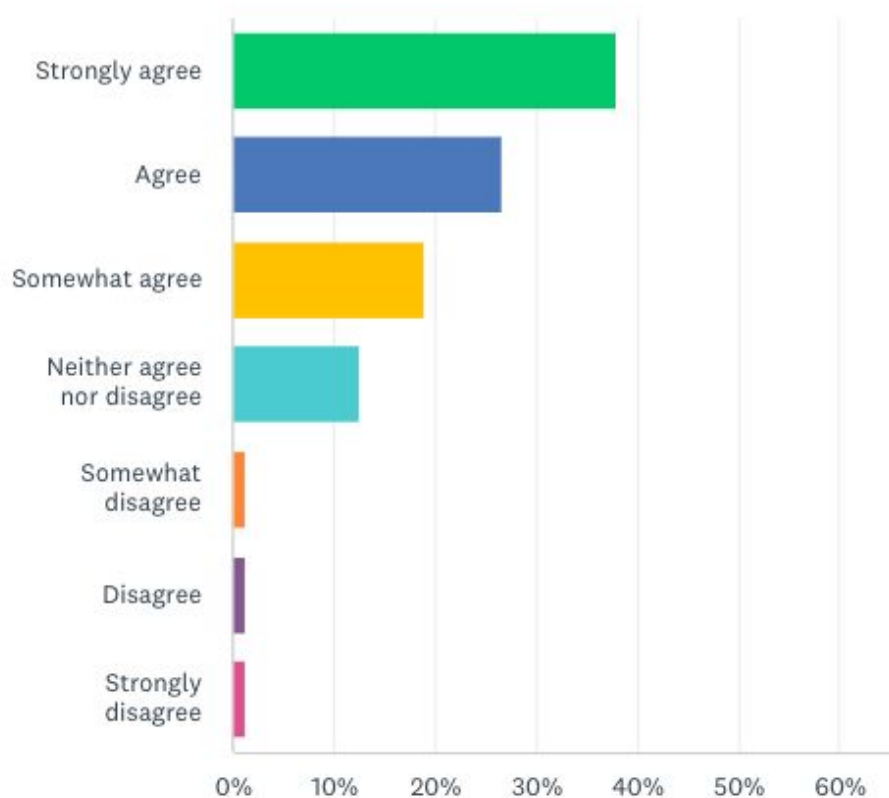

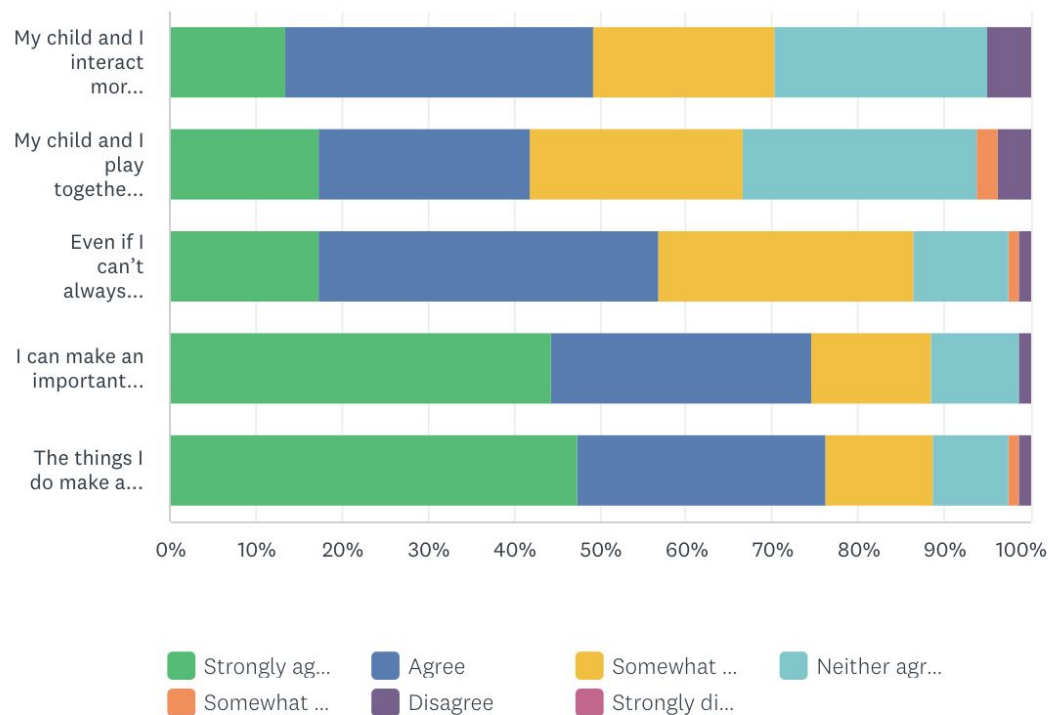
What kind of impact can we achieve together?

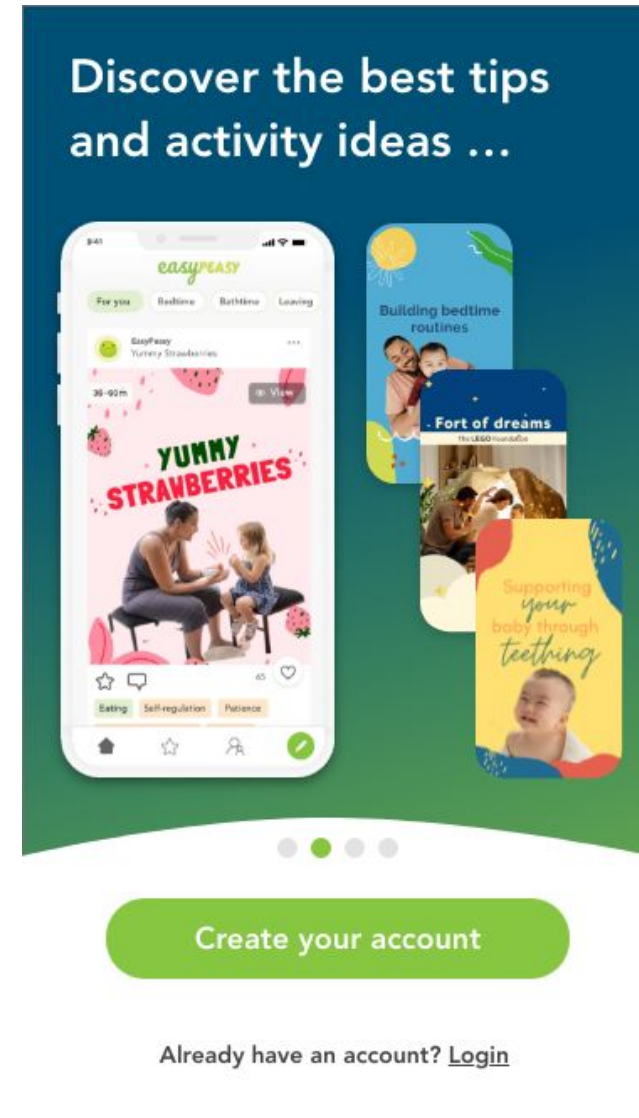

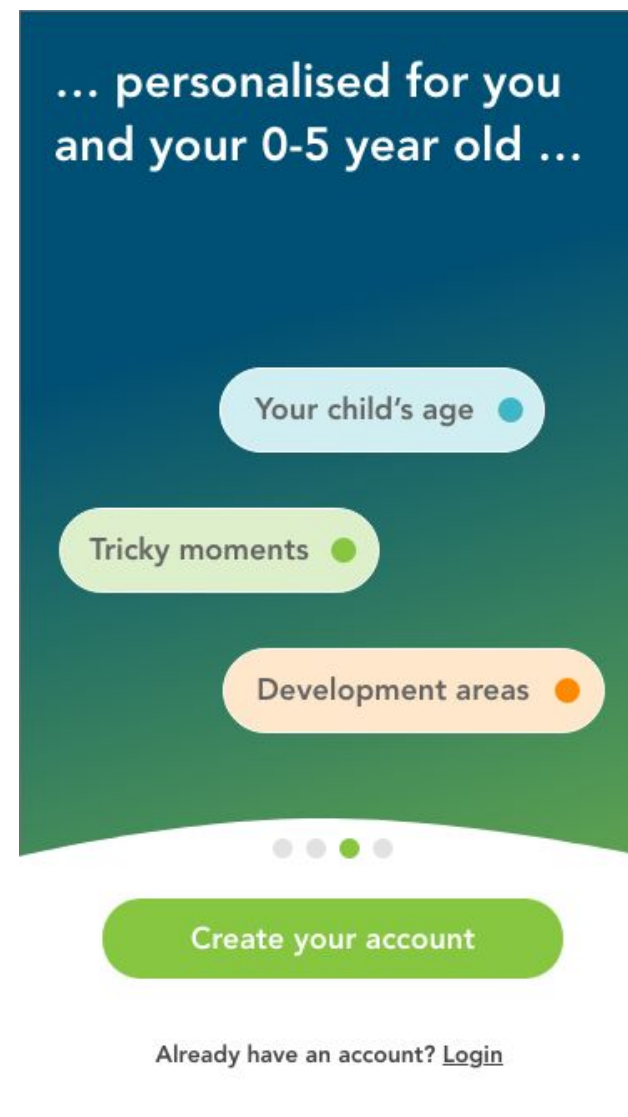
Modern, dynamic content delivery format engages parents, and helps overcome barriers to EAL and hard to engage families.

Our algorithm uses data input by parents to share relevant content for the issues they are facing, and their child's age and stage.



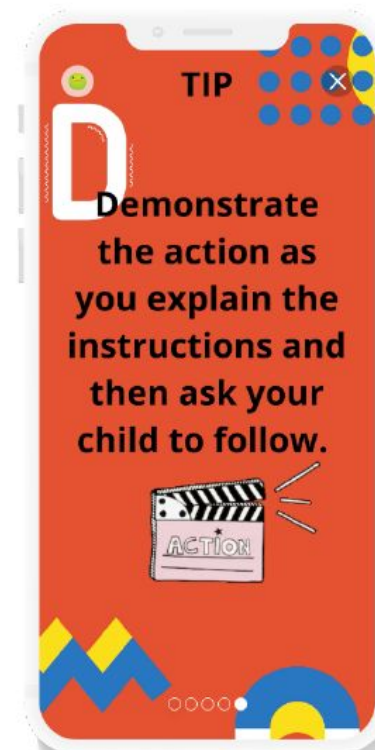
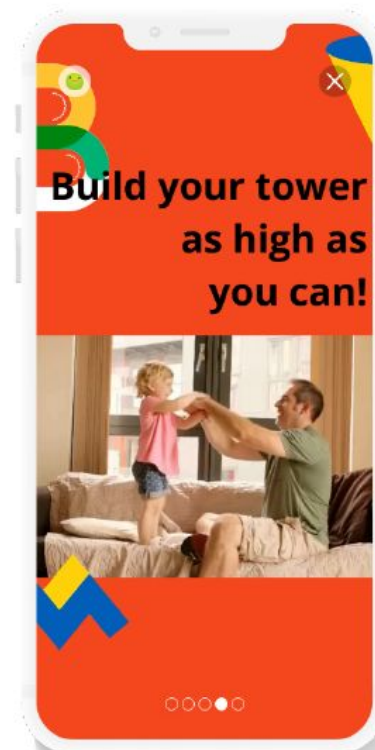
User-generated content

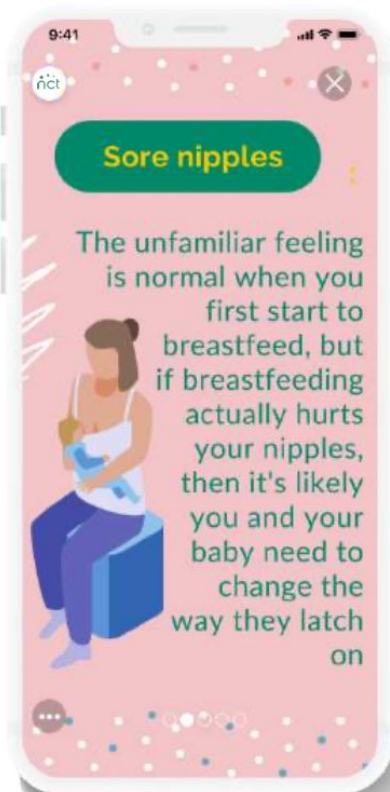

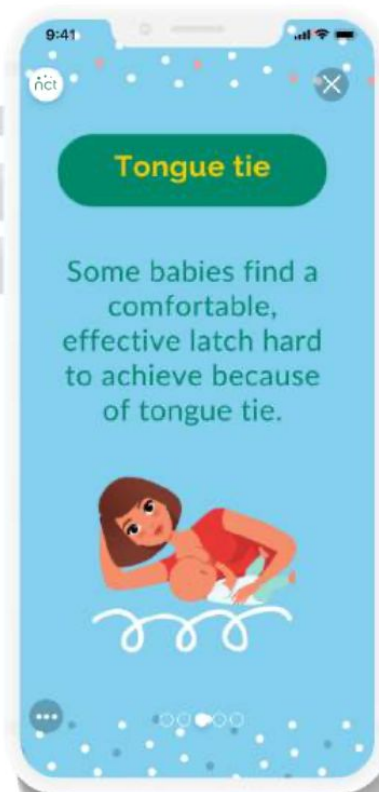

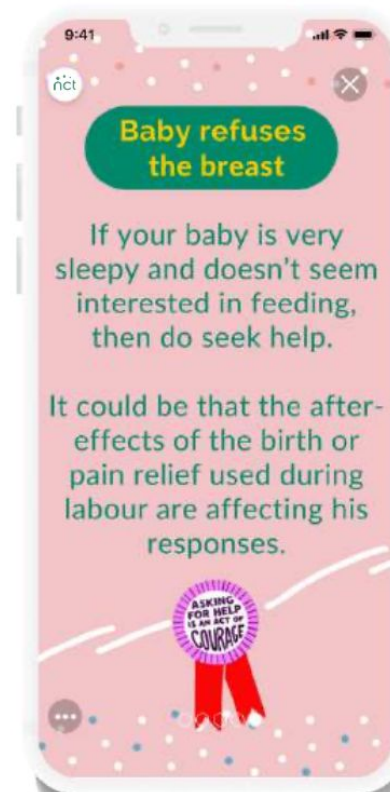
