SCHOOL CLOSED ON WEDNESDAY 1ST MARCH, NEU Teaching Union strike action. The strike is happening because of a national dispute regarding the funding of schools and teachers pay. We are working closely with our staff union representatives and have decided to close our school on Wednesday 1st March. We have not taken this decision lightly. We remain committed to providing a safe and secure environment for our children, and feel that we would be unable to provide this with the staff we have available. We will inform you in due course about plans for Wednesday 15th March and Thursday 16th March.


