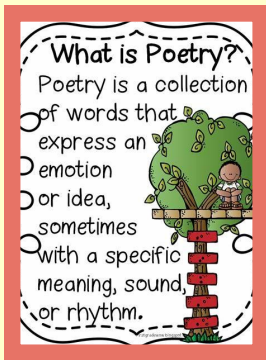

Year 5 Coventry Cathedral Trip as part of this terms topic, we have organised for Year 5 to visit Coventry Cathedral on **Thursday 26th October**. We will be leaving school at 9:30a.m. and return in time for the end of the school day. The children will enjoy a whole day of activities, including a visit to the 'Ruins' in the morning and a 'Blitz' tour in the afternoon. The children will need to bring a packed lunch in a named plastic bag. If your child is entitled to Free School Meals a packed lunch will automatically be provided for them. The cost of the trip is £10.00, which includes the coach travel and entrance to the museum. Please could you make payments and provide consent via the 'My Child At School' app by **Monday 16th October**.

Year 3 Egyptian Workshop can we please ask that £8.00 payment is made via the 'My Child At School' app by **Monday 9th October**.

Year 6 Dol-y-Moch Residential Trip Our Dol-y-Moch visit for the children in Year 6 will be taking place from **Monday 19th February 2024 to Friday 23rd February 2024**. This is a unique opportunity for your child to take part in many outdoor adventures such as kayaking, climbing, abseiling, mountaineering and orienteering as well as learning about the natural environment in the heart of Snowdonia's National Park. The cost of the visit is subsidised, with school covering half the cost of the visit. This year the cost to parents for the trip will be £180.00. In instances where a child changes their mind and no longer wishes to go, we cannot guarantee that the school will be able to refund any payments made and you may have to pay the full amount, including the school's contribution. To enable us to reserve a place for your child, can we please ask that a deposit of **£50.00** is paid by **Friday 13th October**. The remaining cost of the visit (£130.00) can be paid in instalments online and will need to be paid in full by **Monday 22nd January** at the very latest. You are also able to pay the remaining balance in one go if you wish. **Please Note: All payments can be paid via the 'My Child At School' online payment system.** An information meeting for parents has been arranged for **Tuesday 17th October at 4.00p.m.**

This week, **Year 3** enjoyed a nature walk to inspire them to write nature poems on National Poetry Day.



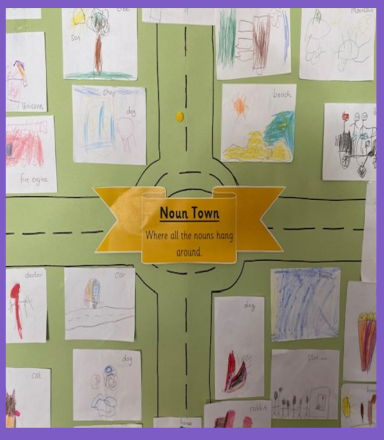
In our Open the Book Assembly, the children in **Year 4** learned the story of Noah's Ark. Some children dressed up as animals and everyone else joined in with the story.
