Reception Trip to Children's Play Village, Monday 13th November to support imaginative play and support understanding of people and communities, which is linked to a wide range of EYFS objectives, the children in Reception will be visiting the Children's Play Village in Warwick. The children will be attending the afternoon session and will return to school by the end of the school day, they will have their lunch before they leave at 11.45p.m. We are asking for a contribution of £16.00 per child to cover the cost of transport and entry into the Play Village. You can make payment and give consent via the 'My Child At School' app. The deadline to do so is **Monday 6th November 2023**.
