





Halloween was so exciting but most of all I loved Bonfire night because I really enjoyed the silent fireworks as they didn't scare me







This week **Year 5** were evacuated to Devon as they are going to be writing a diary entry on the experiences of an evacuee.




Year 1 have been enjoying the story of 'Mr Gumpy's Motor Car' in English. The children have enjoyed thinking about journeys people make.
