- Have fewer behavioural problems

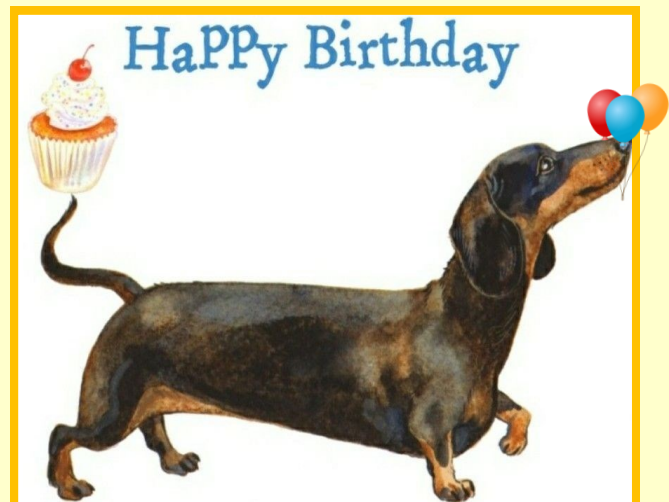

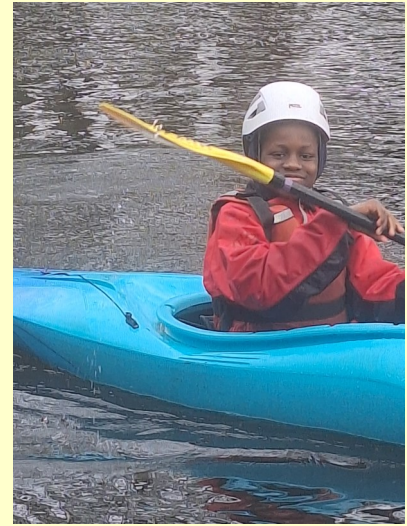

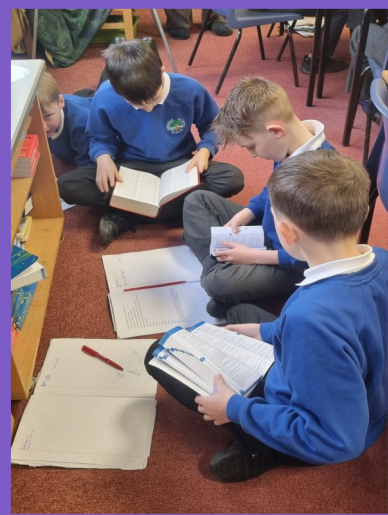
In **Year 1** we have been writing our own instructions about how to decorate biscuits. We loved making our own biscuits. It was so tasty!!
