Coventry City has been a member of the Football League since 1919. They reached the top division for the first time in 1967.

Their highest position in Division 1 was sixth place in the 1969-1970 season. Coventry won the FA Cup in 1987.

Celebrating our week



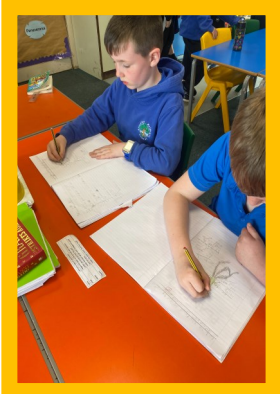
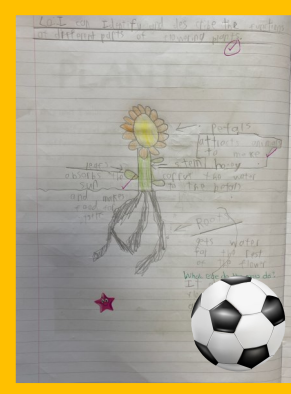
In **Nursery** the children wanted to dress up as pirates. We built a pirate ship and found treasure chests, we then decided we needed more treasure chests so some children went off to make them. We then drew treasure maps and used them to find the buried treasure!



This week in **Year 2** we have been writing a persuasion poster for people to visit various habitats around the world. We have practised writing the 4 types of sentences (statements, commands, exclamations and questions).



We have been using our phonic knowledge, in **Reception**, to write a short sentence from 'The 3 little pigs'.



Year 3 have started their new topic on plants this week. They learnt in this weeks lesson to identify and describe functions of different parts of the plant

This week, **year 1** have been writing their own adventure story based on the tale of *George and the Dragon*.

Year 6 are learning about the circulatory system. Here are two of our investigators exploring the chambers of the heart. They even found the heart strings!
