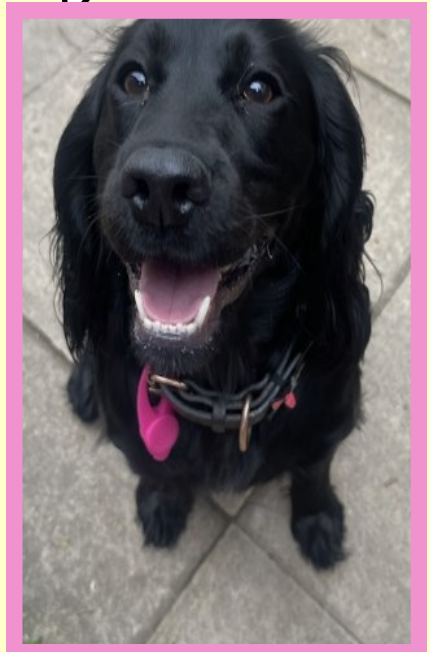

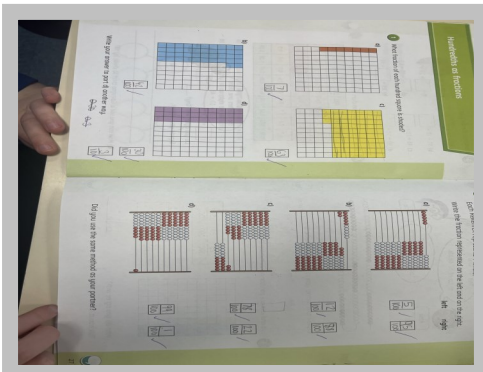
Celebrating our week

Year 4 are currently learning about decimals and fractions. They have been working hard on their Tenths and Hundredths.



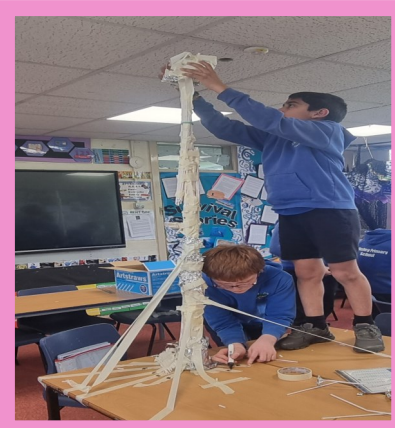
In Nursery we made sensory calming bottles using oil, coloured water, glitter and sparkly bits. We enjoyed turning them upside down to see what happened.
