# celebrating our week



**Year 4** have begun their new Science topic - Electricity. Today they experimented with wires, cells, bulbs and buzzers. They tested to see if the equipment worked correctly by creating circuits.



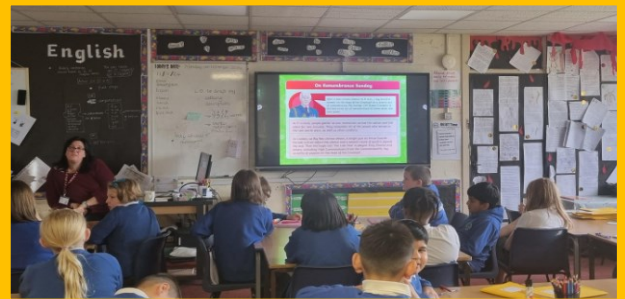
This week **Year 5** were evacuated by steam train to the countryside. This will help them to write their diary entry in English next week.



In **Nursery** we are learning about the Hindu festival of Diwali. The children have enjoyed acting out the story of Rama and Sita.



**Year 3** enjoyed learning and practising new yoga poses and learnt a breathing technique called catch a star.



**Year 6** spent some time during Armistice day reflecting on its importance and sharing any personal experiences. The children showed maturity and respect during our discussions and held a 2 minute silence.
