Class Photo's proof's have been sent home today, if you haven't received yours today it will go home Monday. The deadline to place your order though school is Thursday 3rd April.



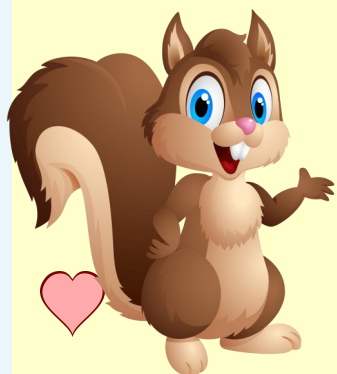

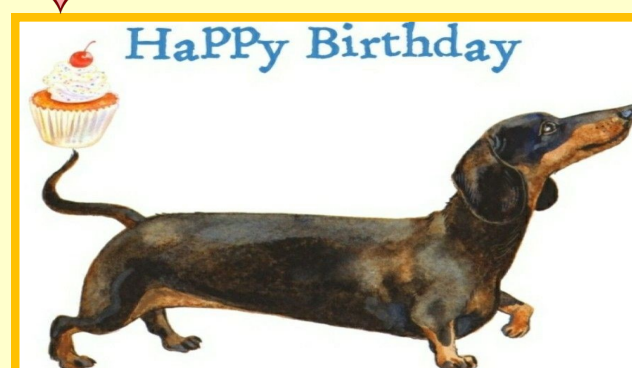

# Celebrating our week



Our Reception children have been learning about spring! We went for a spring walk around school to spot all various signs of spring.



Year 4 re-enacted a Nordic invasion with the Vikings invading a monastery, stealing all the valuables and jewels and capturing the poor, unsuspecting monks to be taken back to their longboats and used as slaves. What a mean bunch they were!



This week in Year 1 R.E the children were learning about the reason why Christians celebrated Easter and why Jesus was there "saviour".



In Year 3 we have been working hard on our tennis skills. We have been learning how to control the ball. Over the last few weeks, we have really improved our skills. Mr Barker is very impressed.



In Year 2 we played class bingo to find out which children are similar. It was lots of fun!

We have been revisiting past spelling rules in Year 5 this week and playing whack-a-mole as part of our spelling practice. Top score was 15!
