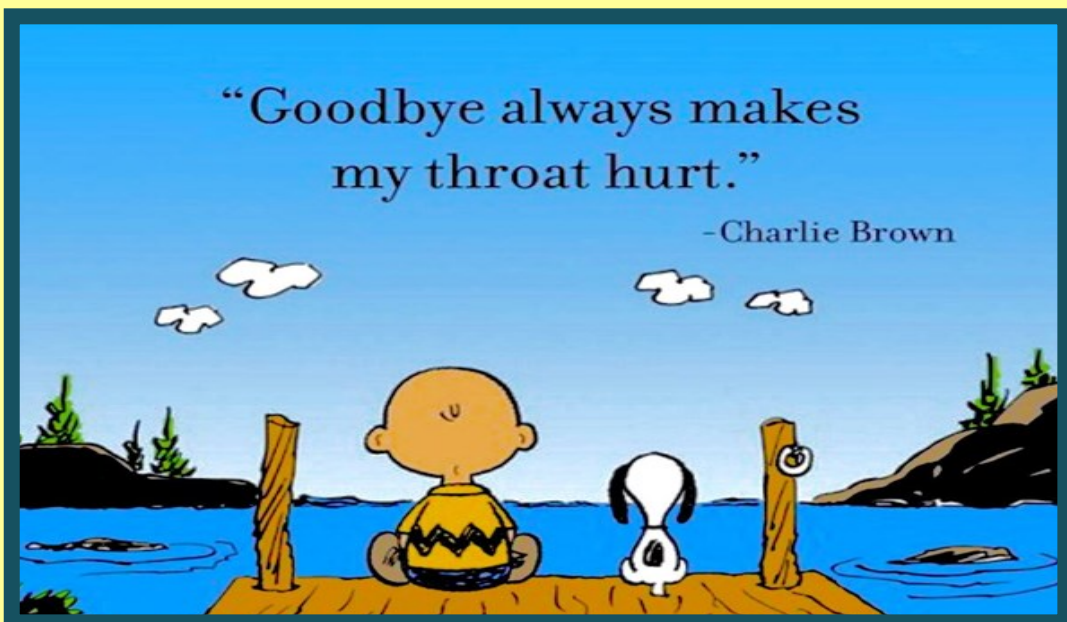

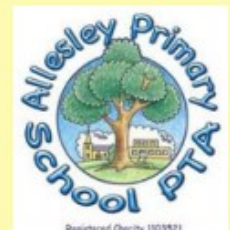

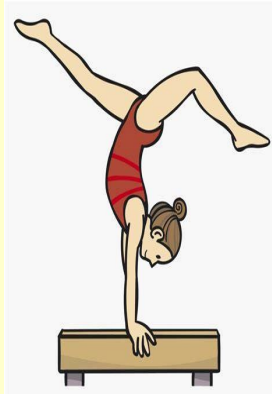

celebrating our week



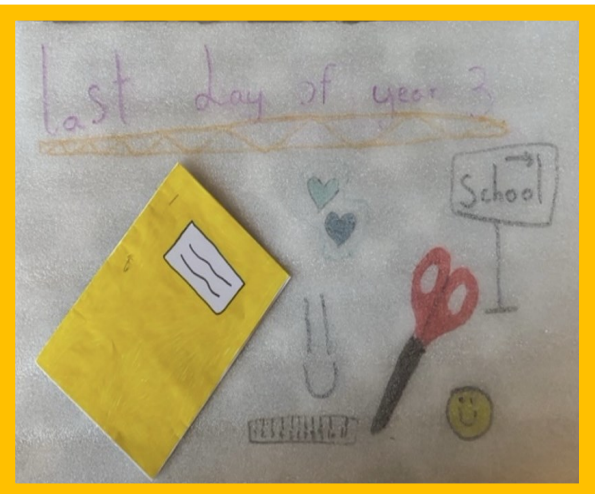
Year 5 talked about how school might be in 2075. We designed buildings and thought about the school day may be different to today.



This week **Year 2** took part in some team building games. We found it challenging, but by the end we all worked much better with each other.



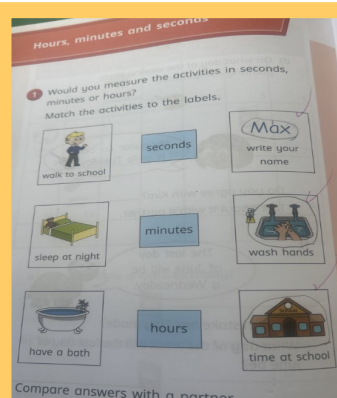
