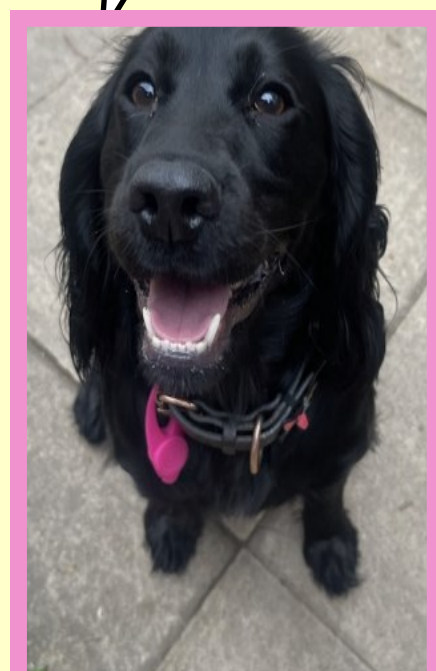

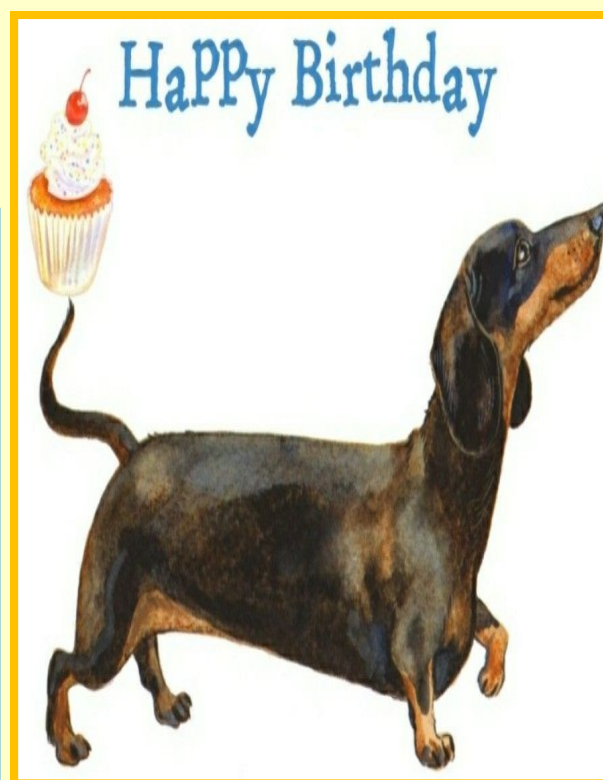

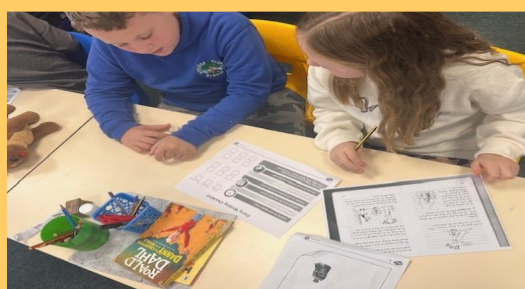


celebrating our week

This week, **Year 1** have been exploring toys from the past. They have been investigating what materials they would have been made from, testing how they would have been played with and comparing them to toys from today.



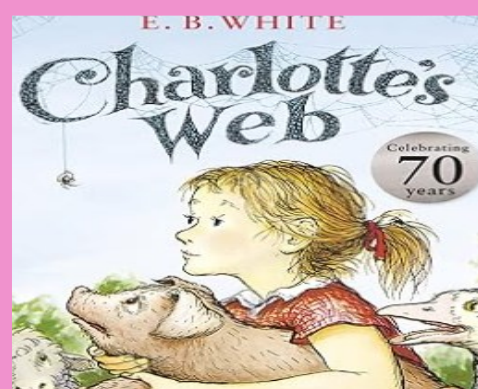
Year 3 have been investigating features of diaries, ready to develop our skills to write diaries of our own.



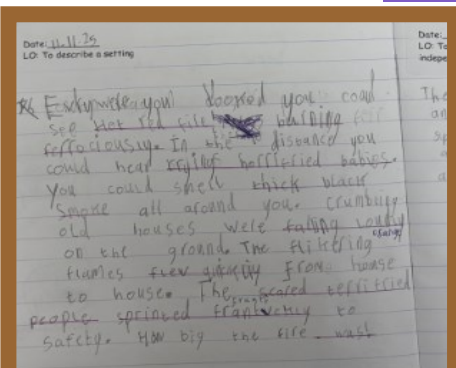
