



Year 3 have been working on lots of English skills this week. This one in particular was our use of fronted adverbials and how we can use them in lots of different sentences.

This week, **Year 2** have been introduced to levers and linkages in DT. They used this knowledge and their amazing creativity to design and create their own monsters made of linkages.



During an exciting orienteering activity, Mr. Barker challenged the **Year 6** children to locate 10 hidden cones around the area. At each cone, they discovered a riddle that required them to think carefully and crack a code. By solving each riddle, the children identified a letter, and once all ten were collected, they worked together to form a final 10-letter word. This activity combined teamwork, navigation skills, and problem-solving, making learning both active and enjoyable.
